Main program

Key speaker Layli Miller-Muro is a Baha’i and founder and executive director of the Taharih Justice Centre in USA, a non-profit, Bahá’í-inspired organization dedicated to protecting women and girls from human rights abuses through the provision of legal aid and public policy advocacy. At the summer school Layli will help us deepen on subjects such as the Baha’i concept of justice, social action and equality between women and men.

The clowning/miming/bouffon couple Amadan from Ireland will be helping us understand and spread joy and creativity at this years summer school. They will work with all age groups, but in particular with the children.



A spirit of service

As a part of this years summer school, all participants will have the chance to do an act of service during the week in order to make the school even better. You can choose your field of service when doing your registration and the committee will assign you a service group. This will increase the spirit of service at the school and is also a good way to meet new friends.



Children

Welcome to a summer school with more focus on children than ever! We want to give the children a warm and safe environment with dedicated and knowledgeable teachers. The program will be Baha'i inspired with a lot of room for joy, friendship, music, learning, development and humour. There will be a program also for the pre-school children. This year the children and their parents will have a separate morning devotional, which will be parallel to the devotional of the main program.

Junior youth

The junior youth (12-15 years) have their own full day program. They will be accompanied by a team of youth from across the country. The program will aim to develop spiritual and intellectual capacities. It consists in studying texts, specially aimed at junior youth combined with arts, outdoor activities, stories and service.

Youth

Key speaker Layli Miller-Muro will also have sessions with the youth. In addition to this several youth and adults will contribute to the program. There will be consultation groups where different subject relevant to our society and the age group will be addressed. We wish that this kind of reflection, deepening and consultation will be an uplifting and empowering learning for the youth, both as individuals and as active participants in service activities, discourses and dialogue groups. The program includes creative and social activities.

Afternoon workshops

In the afternoons you will have the possibility to choose between several workshops, both for deepening and developing creativity. Amongst others there will be workshop on arts, drama, Baha'i testament, Huqúqu' lláh and The 7 valleys. This includes workshops for children and mixed age groups.
